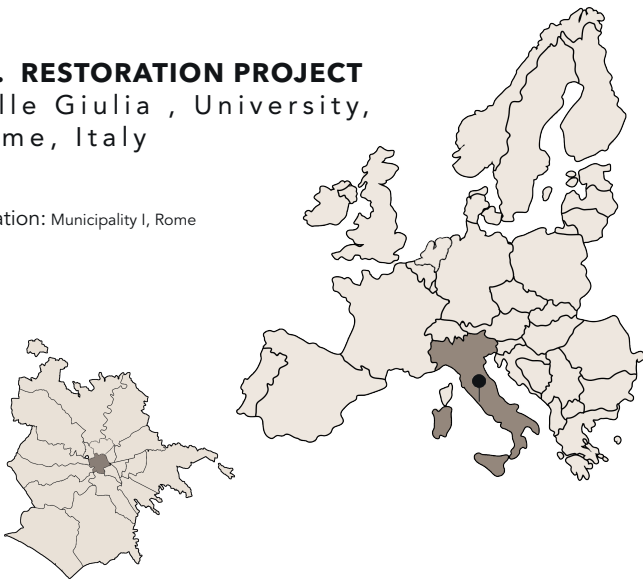


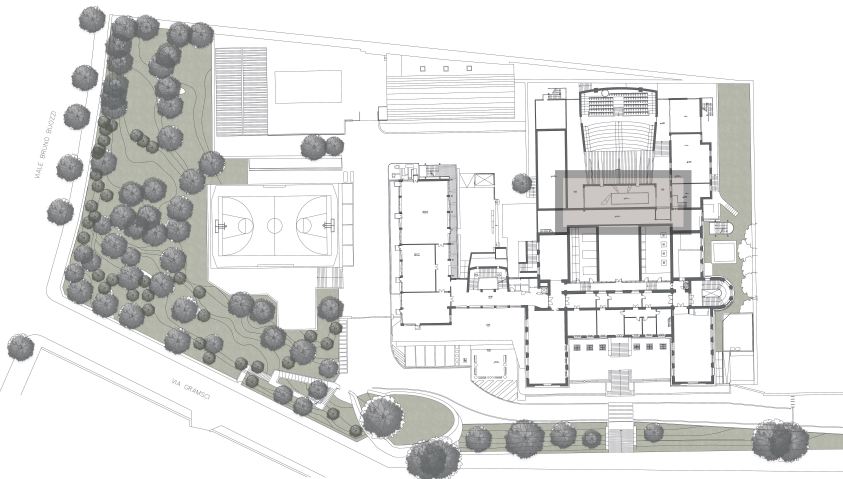
05. RESTORATION PROJECT

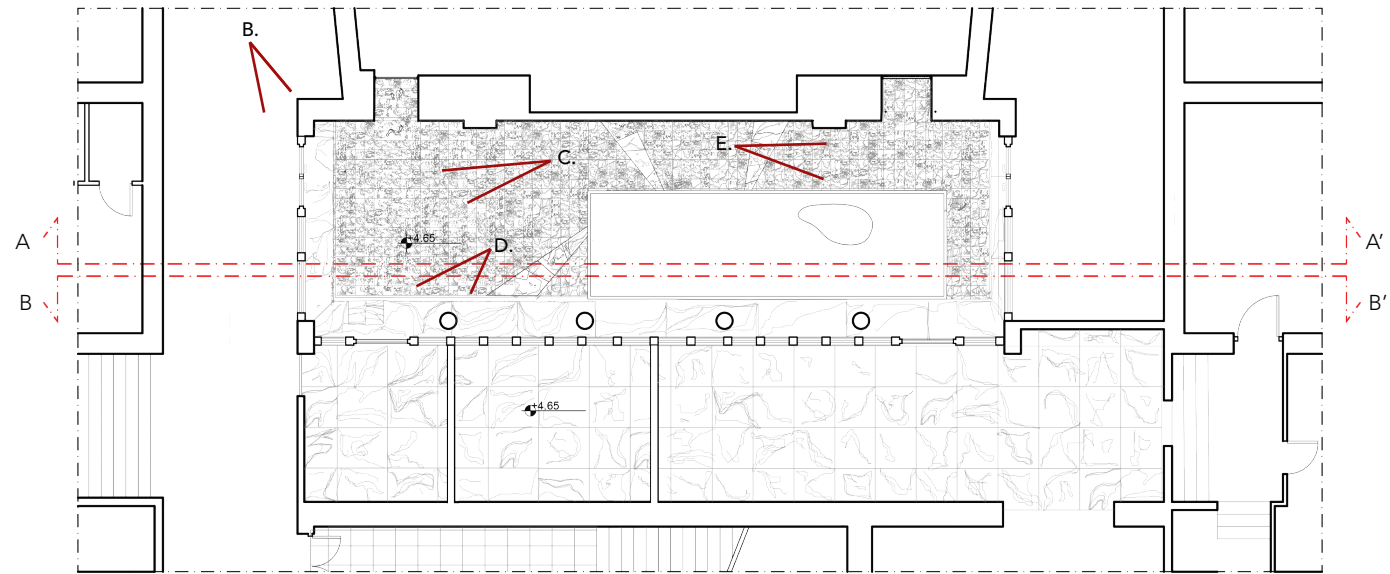
Location: Municipality I, Rome



The project is based on redeveloping an area within the Faculty of Architecture at Sapienza University of Rome. After carrying out photographic and planimetric surveys using trilateration and analyzing the critical aspects of the area, we proceeded to draft the project. In addition to interventions for maintaining the historical parts of the facades and the plants, a new area with the function of a resting area for students is proposed. Therefore, a new covered study area with an internal bar is proposed, which is currently absent within the faculty. Furthermore, inserting a removable external pergola is suggested for use in the area, even in bad weather.



HOW IS IT NOW FIRST FLOOR PLAN



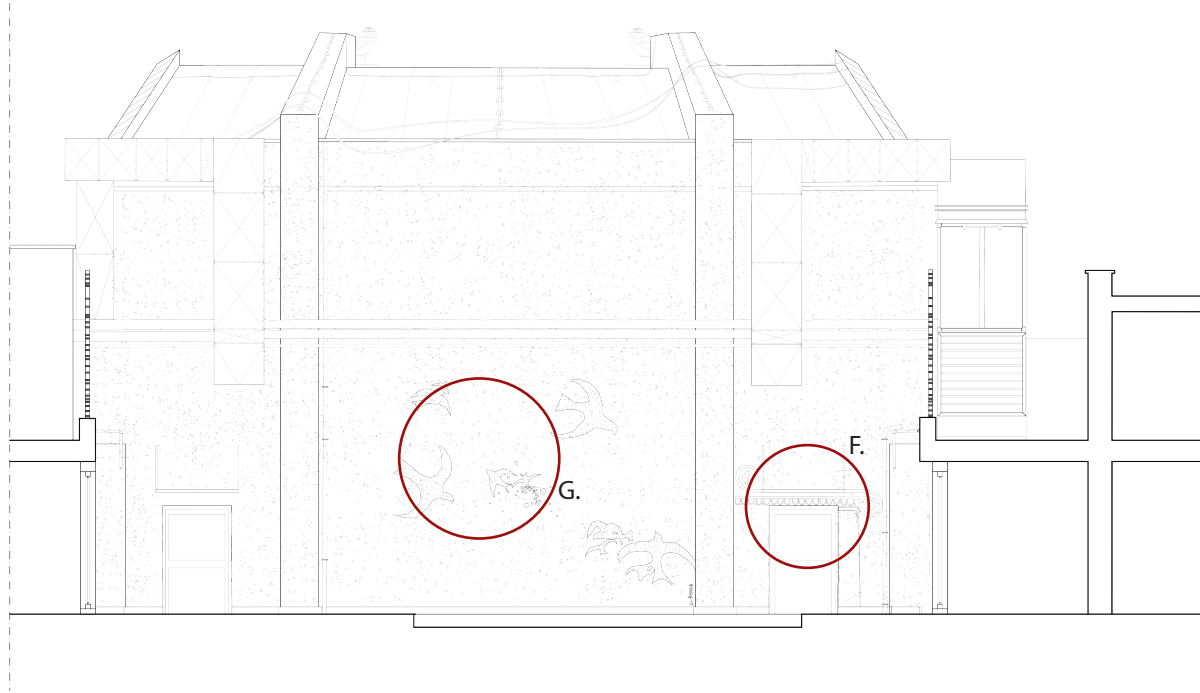

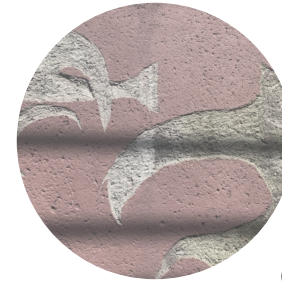

ELEVATION A-A'

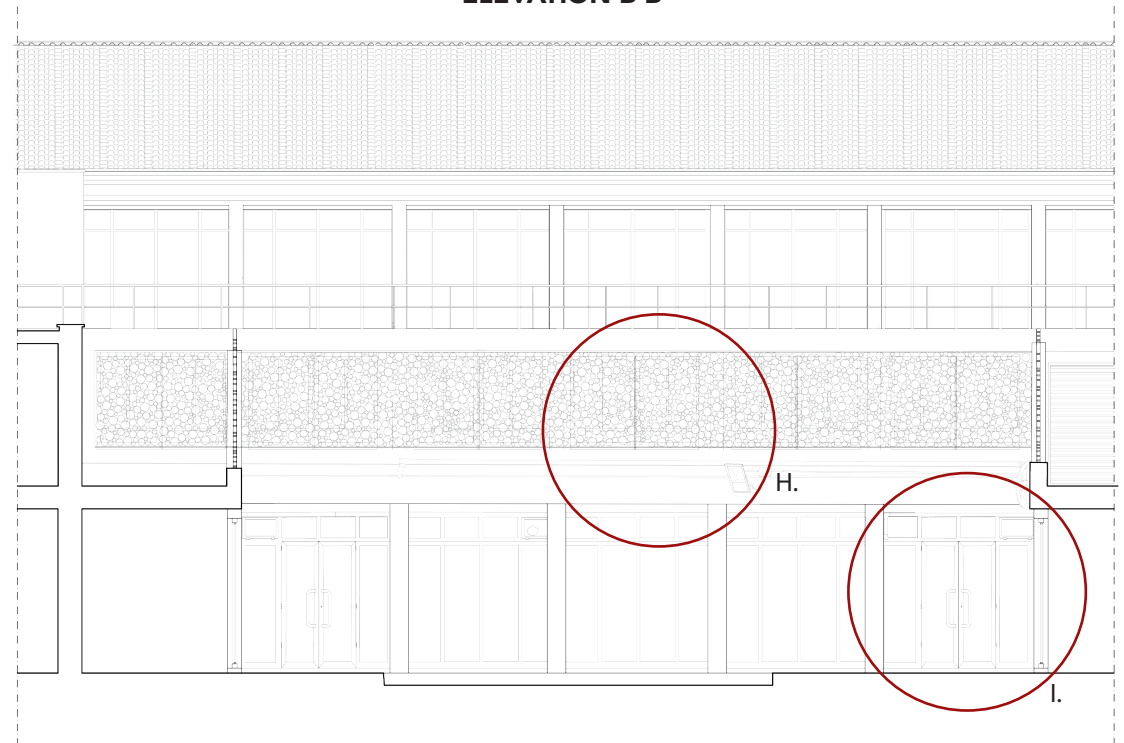

ELEVATION B-B'

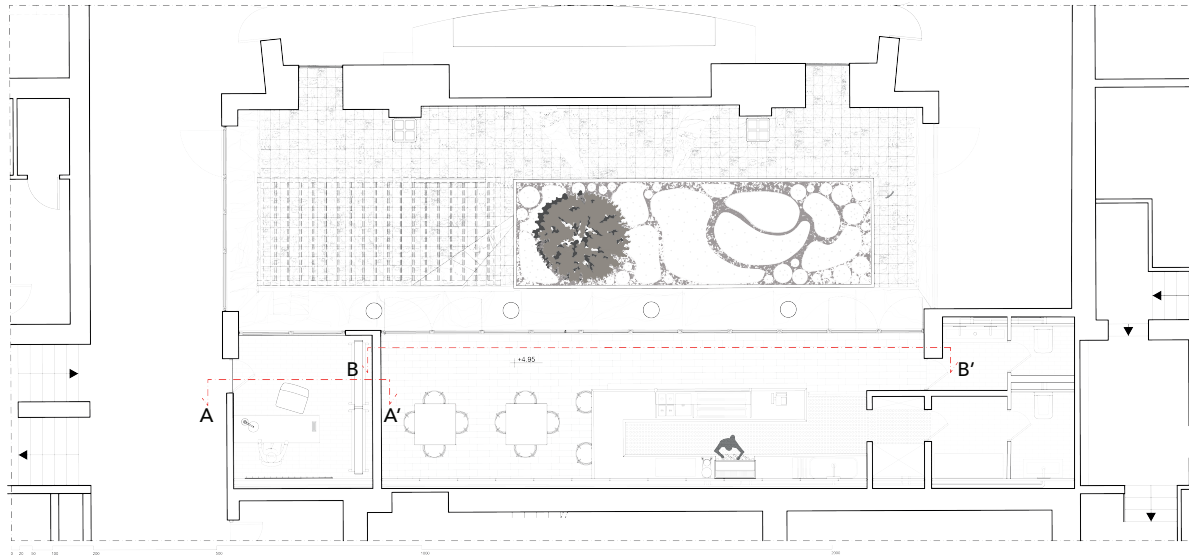

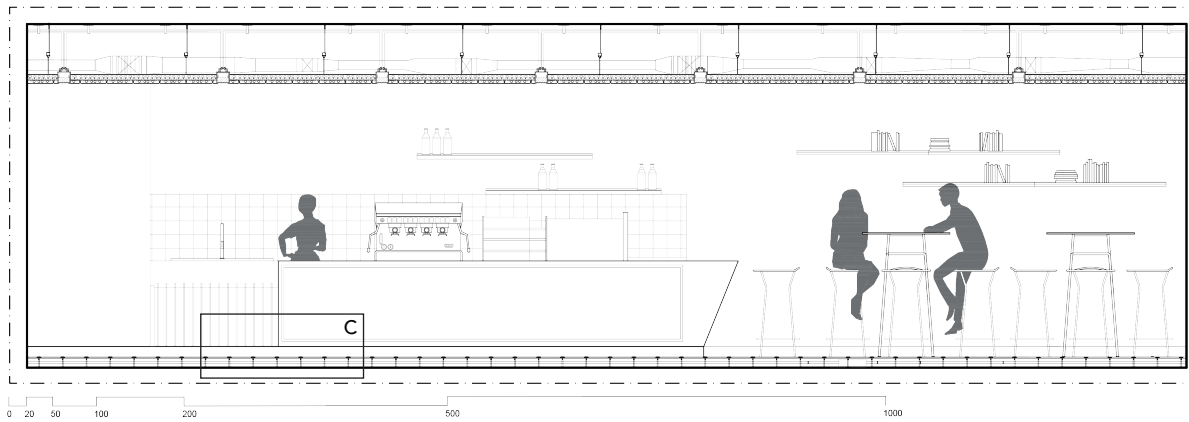

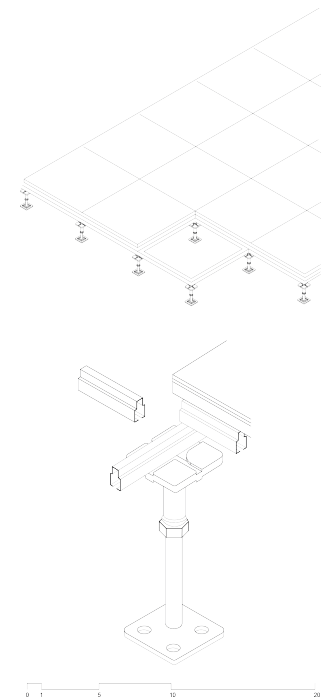
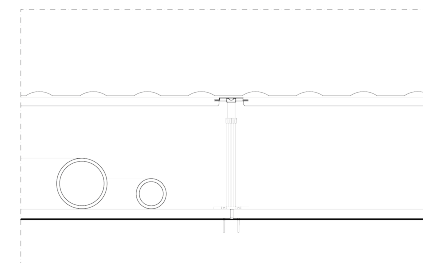
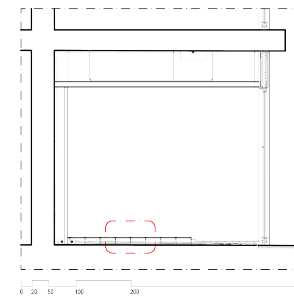
ELEVATION A-A' INFO POINT

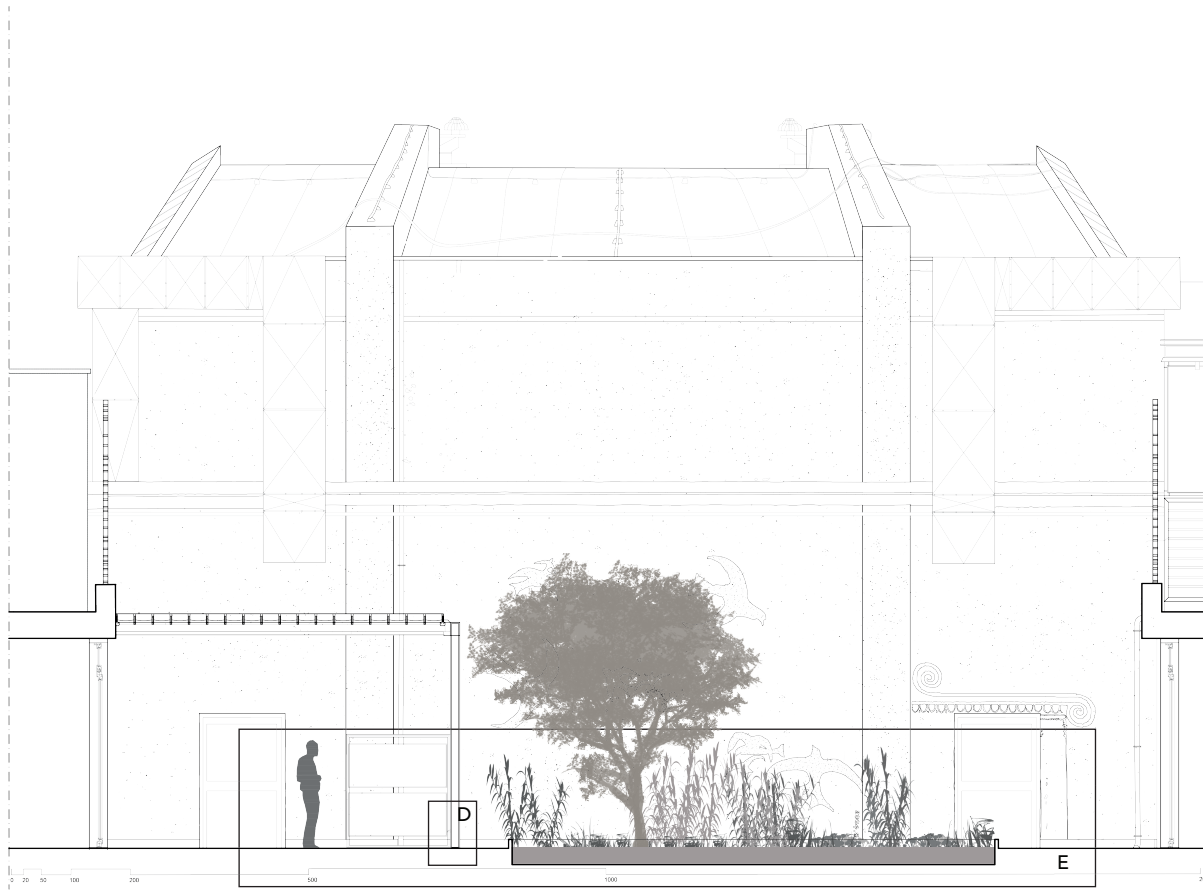


ELEVATION B-B' BAR

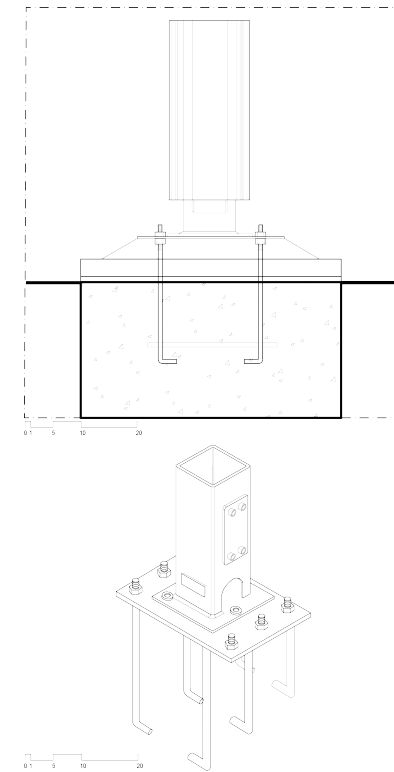


DETAIL C FLOOR
